The student carrying this letter is enrolled in *Learning Disabilities* (15:293:522), a special education course in the Graduate School of Education at Rutgers University, New Brunswick. The Graduate students' project work involves:

I ask that you please allow these students appropriate access to pursue their field-based project, naturally, staying within the procedural requirements of your school.
