Minutes

- Fall Teacher Academy Catalog Mrs. Krial gave an update on the Fall Teacher Academy. There are 21
 sessions, facilitated by teaching staff and administrators. The professional development sessions are
 aligned to the strategic plan. One difference this year is that staff members will receive 1:1 excused
 absence flex time on half-day teacher in-service days in Feb and May for every hour of teacher academy
 attendance.
- 2. Updates to Professional Development Plan and Mentoring Plan with new standards Mrs. Krial also gave an update on the Professional Development Plan and Mentoring Plan. There were no substantive changes since this was recently approved. The changes were simply formatting on PDP and frequency of mentor meetings on Mentoring Plan as per no state requirements.
- 3. NJSLA Results Review Dr. Brown, Mrs. Pauch, Mrs. Beegle, and Mr. Tumolo gave a draft presentation on the NJSLA results from the Spring, which will be shown to Board Members at the October Board Meeting. Students have shown tremendous growth in ELA, Math, and Science, outperforming the state average in every grade level. These results also show that student performance has returned to pre-pandemic levels in ELA and Science in all grades and most grades in Math. Dynamic Learning Map Grades and Multilingual Learners also showed tremendous improvement. The Multilingual Learner cohort, which has students cycle in and out, has seen a lot of flux over the past several years so those results are not fully reliable.
- 4. Curricular Revisions Sections of 9.4 Standards Career Readiness have been updated to comply with QSAC. Detailed updates are listed below.

A board member questioned the book 'George' by Alex Gino, which is an optional book in the 6th Grade ELA Curriculum. Administrators responded that 'George' has been in the curriculum since 2017. Parents were notified in the beginning of the year that this book is available as an optional read and they could

opt out if they don't want their child reading it. The notification letter is posted on the weekly genesis. Several parents have asked to preview the book, which they did. A book challenge would need to be submitted to remove this book from the curriculum.

 Assessment Calendar and NAEP - Dr. Hart notified the committee that our district was selected to take the National Assessment of Educational Progress for 4th grade this year in Math and ELA. Only a handful of students will be asked to participate, the State will administer the test sometime between Jan 29- Mar 8. The Assessment Calendar will be updated to reflect this additional assessment.
