- 1. District Logo Project
 - a. Committee narrowed down to 4, providing feedback for revisions to those students.
 - b. Committee will review revisions, send 3 out for community vote. All students who participated will be recognized at either the BOE meeting in June or the beginning of 2021-2022 school year
- 2. Summer Enrichment Enrollment Update
 - a. 126 registrations, 7 facilitators. Program will be self-sustaining this year.
- 3. Special Education Supplemental Reading Program
 - a. Moving towards specific programs rather than strategies from various programs for consistency across the district. Providing PD for teachers.
 - i. Wilson Fundations and Heggerty Phonemic Awareness K-3
 - ii. Just Words Program 4-5
 - 1. Provides better monitoring and progress reports
- 4. Summer Accelerate Learning Enrollment Update and Interventions This Year
 - a. Summer Accelerate Learning: 4 week program for Math and LA
 - i. LA: 20 students per grade level were invited
 - ii. Math: 100 students total invited K-8
 - b. Fall Accelerate Learning: 2-3 days per week after school; fall Start Strong state assessments may be used to identify students
 - c. ESY: added an hour per day for COVID recovery
 - d. Retention/Credit Recovery Program: Offering 4th marking period recovery during afternoon office hours at RMS, in person or virtual, for students at risk of retention or failure. K-1 students at risk of retention are being offered support and possibly summer enrollment in the accelerate program. Focus on literacy and math.
- 5. SEL
 - a. Hunterdon Behavioral Health
 - i. Roadmap of Tiered support based on student needs. Tier 3 Support would receive Hunterdon Behavioral Health one-one intensive counseling
 - b. Equity Update tabled
