



# Enrollment Trends and Current Enrollment

## Our Enrollment History



Data taken from budget presentation March 2023

\*Projected and includes 121 students from The Ridge at Readington

### Enrollment Forecast 2023-2024

(taken from the March 2022 budget presentation)

- Anticipated PreK-8 enrollment = **1,506**
- Presumes:
  - ▶ 134 Kindergarten students
- > 121 new students from The Ridge at Readington

#### Comparisons:

September 2022-2023 enrollment = **1416** 

June 2022-2023 enrollment = **1,426**

## The Ridge at Readington (Route 22 West)


#### 254 total units

64 affordable units (25%) 12 one bed, 39 two bed, 13 three bed

190 market rate units (75%) 58 one bed, 132 two bed, 0 three bed

# 3. The Redistricting Project

## Phase In Approach: A 5 Year Plan

**2021-2022** School Year: Offer families who register for Kindergarten in this redistrict area the option to attend WHS or TBS. All new move-ins would be districted to TBS. (Complete)

**2022-2023** School Year: All entering Kindergarten students in the redistrict area would attend TBS. All new move-ins would be districted to TBS.

**2023-2024** School Year: All entering Kindergarten students in the redistrict area would attend TBS. First grade will continue at TBS. All new move-ins would be districted to TBS. (In process)

**2024-2025** School Year: All entering Kindergarten students in the redistrict area would attend TBS. First and second grade will continue at TBS. All new move-ins would be districted to TBS.

**2025-2026** School Year: All entering Kindergarten students in the redistrict area would attend TBS. First, second, third grade will continue at TBS. All new move-ins would be districted to TBS.

## Results of Year 3 Implementation: Kindergarten and Newly Enrolled Families

#### Kindergarten

School	Current Enrollment	Redistricted Students	Impact	Without Redistricting
Whitehouse School	70	11	-11	81
Three Bridges School	63		+11	52

#### Grades 1-3

There was an *additional* 1 student in grades 2 & 3 who was redistricted from WHS to TBS.

## Total Impact

2022-2023: 12 Kindergarteners and 10 students grades 1-3 were redistricted to TBS.

2023-2024: 11 Kindergarteners and 1 student in grades 2-3 were redistricted to TBS.

Total over 2 years: 34
