1. Health/Vision & Dental Insurance Renewals - Brown & Brown presented to the Committee

AmeriHealth Medical Plan - 2% increase effective 7/1/21 - 6/30/22

# 3. 2021-2022 Capital Projects

- Roofing project
  - Kickoff meeting occurred May 4. Plan is to begin project on June 21.
  - Lead time for metal panels, block and coping (submittals pending)
- o RMS bleachers replacement
  - ESCNJ bid awarded, PO issued, kickoff meeting pending, 4-5 month lead time on bleachers Nickerson awarded contract.
- Other maintenance/IT projects

Paint lockers, floor work, sidewalk and window repairs - possible projects for summer of 2022.

#### 4. Food Service

- Bid results from May 6, incorporated sustainability requests Maschios will likely be awarded bid.
  Currently under attorney review.
- o Current Maschios staffing 3 persons. Usually operate with 8-9 staff.
- Full-day reopening options (doesn't appear practical at this late date)
  - SSO Program
  - Continue delivery (no in-person service), students bring food
  - Standard lunch with precautions / elementary schools first then intermediate/middle school
  - Centralized prepackaged meals (limited options) delivered to each school
- o 2021-2022 school year discussion:
  - SSO Program All ordered meals will be reimbursed by the federal government
  - Lunch room vs. classroom vs. hybrid
  - Social distancing (additional lunch periods of shorter duration or standard lunch)
  - Food choices (limited at first, then expand)
  - Prepackaged grab-and-go vs. normal lunch line / buffet
  - Outside food discussion regarding ordering pizza from local vendor
  - Snacks to be offered at the start of the school year
- o Breakfast through SSO Breakfast Program to be discussed at a later date

### 5. Grants

- CRRSA / ESSER II (2nd federal stimulus)
  - Hunterdon Behavioral Health contract to provide additional mental health services for 2 years. Presentation at board meeting in June
- American Rescue Act / ESSER III (3rd federal stimulus) amounts TBD in approx 2 months funds will be available through September 2024
- o Securing our Childrens' Future Bond Act still under state review
