- 1. Energy Program Updates / New Energy Baseline Jodi Bettermann
  - We now use SiteWatch (Operations and Energy Management software)
  - New energy baseline year (June 2018 June 2019), which includes the solar panels. The old baseline year was 2011-2012.
  - The baseline year is now aligned with the fiscal year
  - Spring 2020 showed a Covid-schools-closing effect on electricity usage which will (hopefully/probably) not be repeated. Net gas usage also dropped.
  - There was a \$44,000 energy savings (compared to new baseline year).
  - Solar installations provided 38% of total district electricity usage. At HBS it was 87% of the contracted production, and 103% at RMS & TBS. There is a 5-year true-up period.
  - Energy Program transition is underway.
  - Grant closeouts some are on extension (TBS Tower Gardens, WHS water to garden, Sustainable Jersey Small Grants Program/Gardinier Environmental Fund Grant – power monitors [tie into SiteWatch])
  - Sustainable Jersey for Schools recertification year. Students involved in application?
