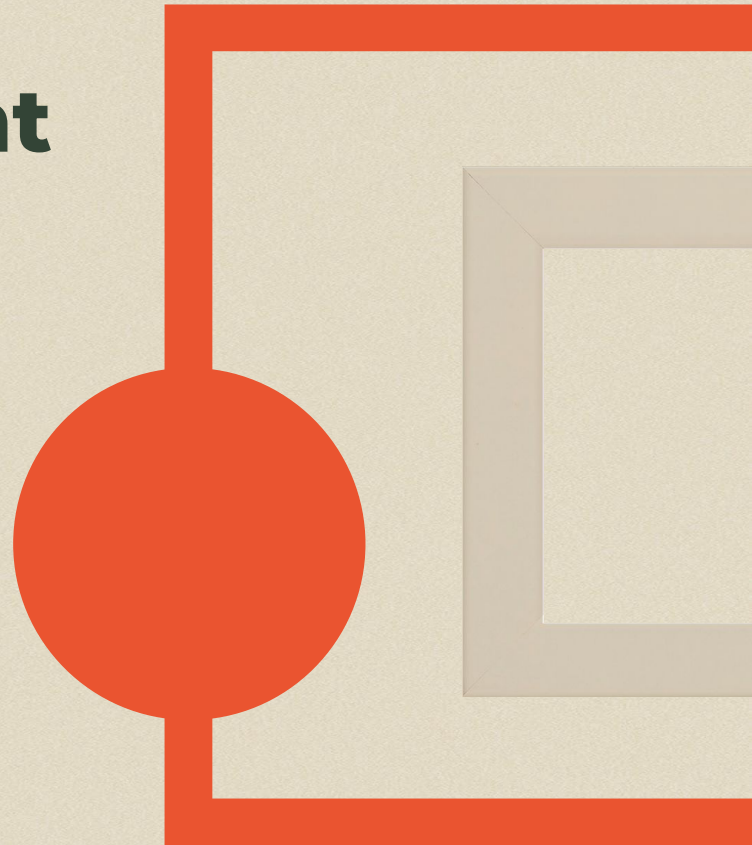

Process for Determining and Submitting Scores

- School Climate Team led by School Counselor and/or Principal completes the self assessment
- Building results are reported to Anti-Bullying Coordinator
- Data is compiled and presented to Board of Education upon approval from building principals and the Anti-Bullying Specialists
- Self Assessment results are entered onto the NJDOE website for final submission
- Official release of grade report is posted on the district's website once made available by the state.

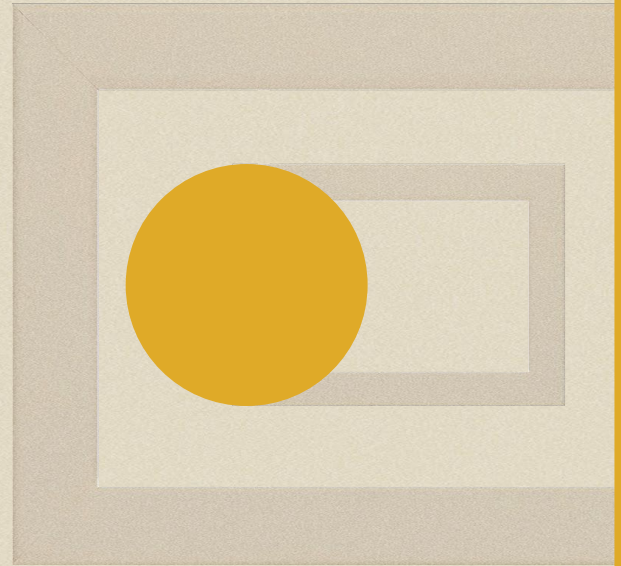


Self Assessment Scoring Rubric

8 Core Elements:

- HIB Programs, Approaches or Other Initiatives
- Training on the BOE-approved HIB Policy
- Other Staff Instruction and Training Programs
- Curriculum and Instruction on HIB and Related Information and Skills
- HIB Personnel
- School-Level HIB Incident Reporting Procedure
- HIB Investigation Procedure
- HIB Reporting

*There are indicators within each core element.
There are a total of **26 indicators**.

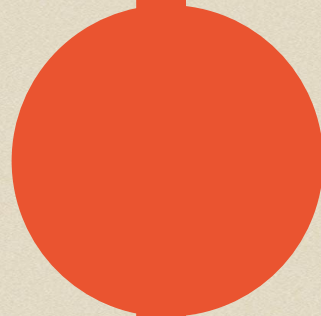


Grading Scale for Each Indicator within each Core Element:

- 0-Does Not Meet the Requirements
- 1- Partially Meets the Requirements
- 2-Meets All Requirements
- 3-Exceeds Requirements

Highest Possible Score is 78.

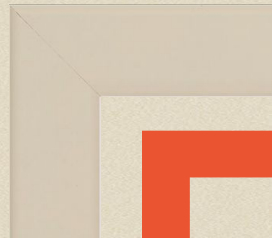
Note: If a school met all requirements and received a 2 (meets all requirements) for every indicator, their final score would be a 52.

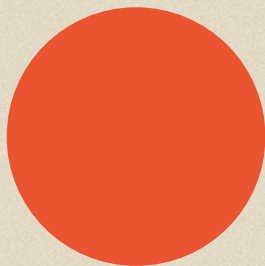

- Administer the NJ School Climate Survey to annually assess HIB programs, approaches or other initiatives.

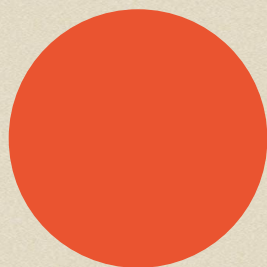
Core Element 2

Other Staff Instruction and Training:

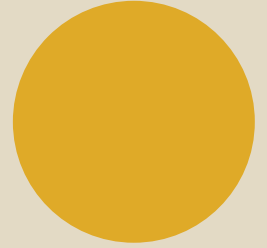
- Continue to provide staff training on HIB policies and prevention.

Timeline for Submission NJ Homeroom



1. Enter Self Assessment Scores for each building on NJ Homeroom (*Deadline for submission is December of 2022*)
2. Once data is entered, then certify results to receive state of assurances.
3. Wait for the state to generate an official district score report to be posted on our district website. (*One year behind*)
