QSAC Results 2023-2024

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What is QSAC?

The New Jersey Quality Single Accountability Continuum (NJQSAC) is:

- The NJ Department of Education monitoring system
- Self-evaluation tool combined with state-issued scores
- Shift the monitoring/evaluation focus from compliance to assistance and capacity-building
- Includes state laws and federally funded requirements
- The focus is monitoring districts in 5 key areas known as District Performance Review (DPR) areas: Fiscal, Governance, Instruction and Program, Operations, and Personnel.

Our Self-Assessment Scores

After our internal self-assessment with a committee of stakeholders, we evaluated our DPRs as follows:

Instruction and Program: 40% (the other 60% is calculated by the DOE)

Fiscal Management: 100%

Governance: 100%

Operations: 100%

Personnel: 100%



State Returned Scores

After the state reviewed our self-assessment and supporting documentation, we received the following scores:

Instruction and Program: 81%

Fiscal Management: 100%

Governance: 100%

Operations: 96%

Personnel: 100%

We have satisfied the 80% minimum requirement for each DPR, thus we maintain our status as a **high performing** district.

Instruction and Program Score Explanation

The Instruction and Program score is provided to us by the Department of Education. It considers 2 parts:

- Achievement Scores (41/60 points)
- Curriculum and Policy (40/40 points)

Our weighted achievement scores and academic progress scores in ELA, math, and science are areas where some points were not earned.

We received all points for Curriculum and Policy.

Instruction and Program Achievement Subscores

Indicator 1: ELA achievement (overall and subgroups) 6.7/10

Indicator 2: Math achievement (overall and subgroups) 5.4/10

Indicator 3: Science achievement (overall and subgroups) 3.3/10

Indicator 4: ELA growth (overall and subgroups) 8.4/10

Indicator 5: Math growth (overall and subgroups) 8.0/10

Indicator 6: Graduation rate N/A

Indicator 7: Overall school quality and student success 8.8/10

Operations Areas of Comment and Corrective Action

Indicator 12: Comprehensive record of immunizations, required physical exams and health screenings are maintained... (N.J.A.C. 6A:16-2.1, N.J.A.C. 6A: 32-7.4).

Comment: The County made a comment that the district has incomplete health screening records. This was due to the fact that we did not have updated screenings in medical files for 5 out-of-district students.

Corrective Action: Internal protocol put in place to annually update these files at each IEP annual review meeting.

Conclusion

There are no comments on the Personnel, Fiscal and Governance DPRs. This 100% score suggests that protocols and procedures in these areas are well within compliance.

There is one area where we lost points and received a comment. We have already developed a remedy with internal protocols.

The feedback provided allows for more capacity-building.

We maintain our status as a high performing district! The Commissioner of Education will recommend to the State Board of Education that the district be certified as high performing and providing a thorough and efficient system of education.
