- **Food Drive** (Nov/Dec) collect non-perishable food items to help support the Flemington Food Pantry and Starfish Foundation
- **Giving Tree** (Dec) collect new hats, mittens and scarves for Starfish Foundation and the Flemington Food Pantry
- **Sweet Message Project** (Feb) donate a quarter (replaced with Hershey kiss) to send message to a friend (ALL Hershey kisses are generously donated by local businesses.) All money collected is donated to the Hunterdon Medical Center – pediatric and maternity ward.
- **Math-a-Thon** (Feb/Mar) parents, friends to sponsor a student for the number of math problems solved. All money collected is donated to the St. Jude Children's Research Hospital for children afflicted with cancer.
