



Readington EAP Agreement

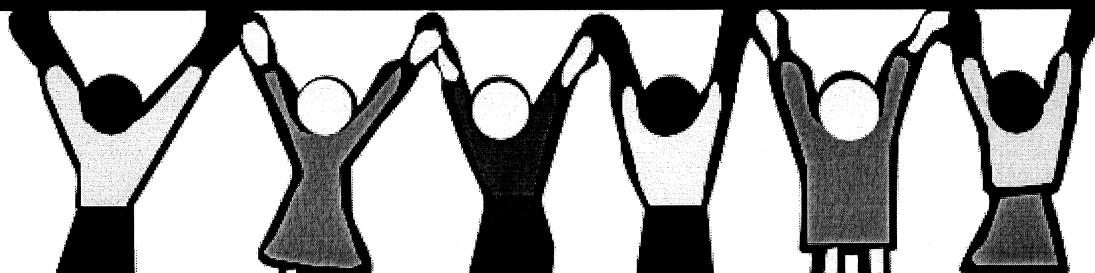
Prevention Resources agrees to provide the following:

- Provide outpatient counseling with credentialed therapists in all areas: marital, grief and loss, adolescents, life transitions, mental health, interventions, substance use/misuse, certified tobacco cessation, parenting, and anger management;
- For ease of use, the EAP is in a fully accessible facility in a central location, ample parking close to the office, and a professional, inviting and family-oriented office space;
- Requested appointments will be made within a week of request for individuals under extreme duress, compared to other organizations with several week waiting lists to obtain an appointment;
- EAP offers On-site staff training on a myriad of topics, a few of which are: Drug Abuse Trends, Raising resilient Children, Prevention Strategies, and much more;
- We offer up to ten sessions per employee as well as employee family members. Most other EAP's generally offer up to three or four sessions. This translates into greater problem resolution for individuals seeking help;
