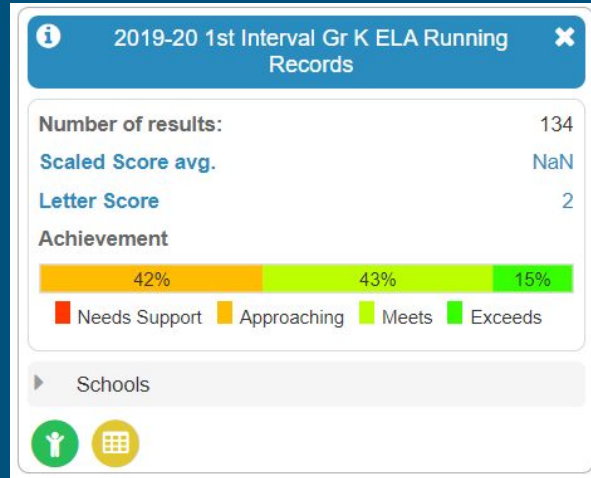
The Reality of This Year

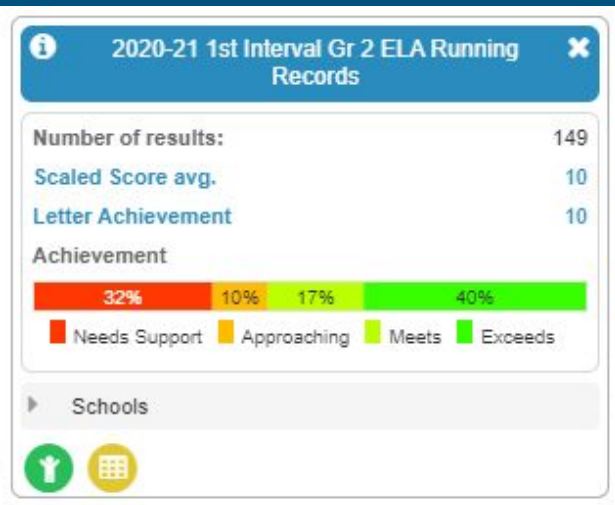

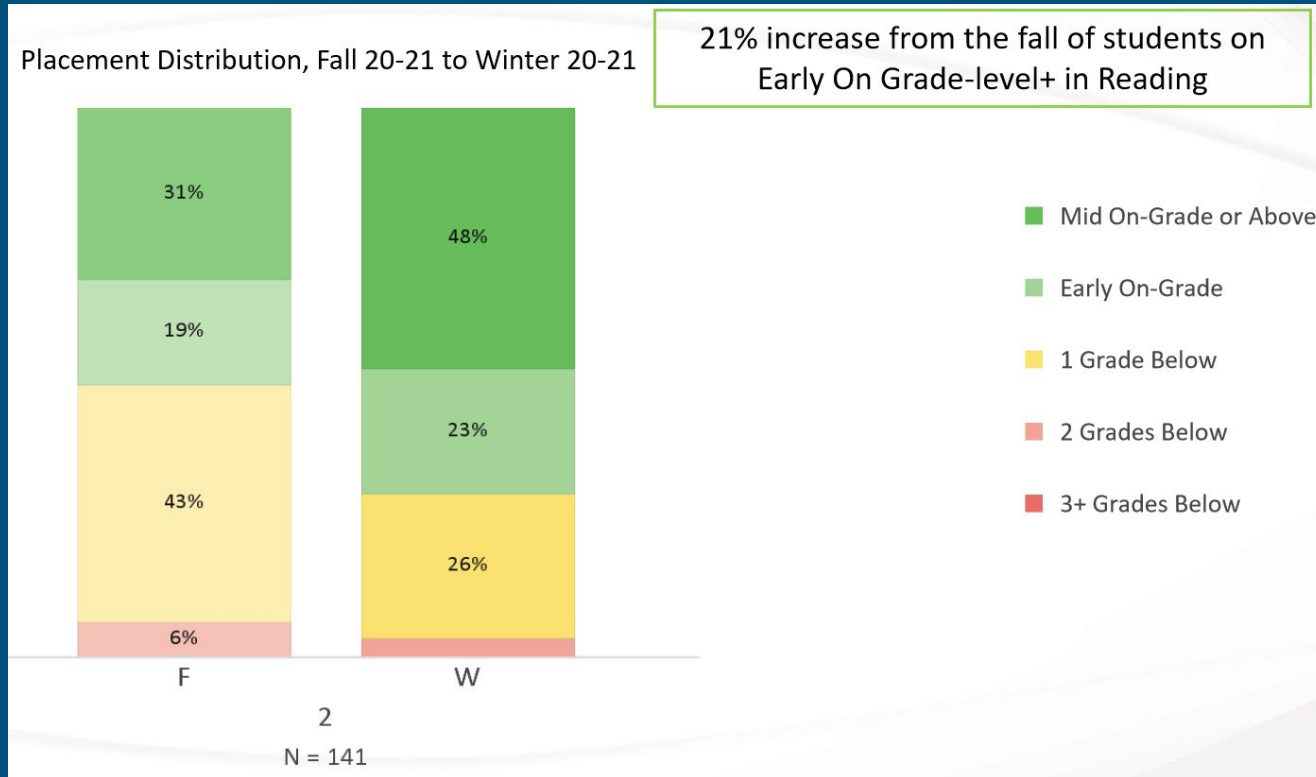

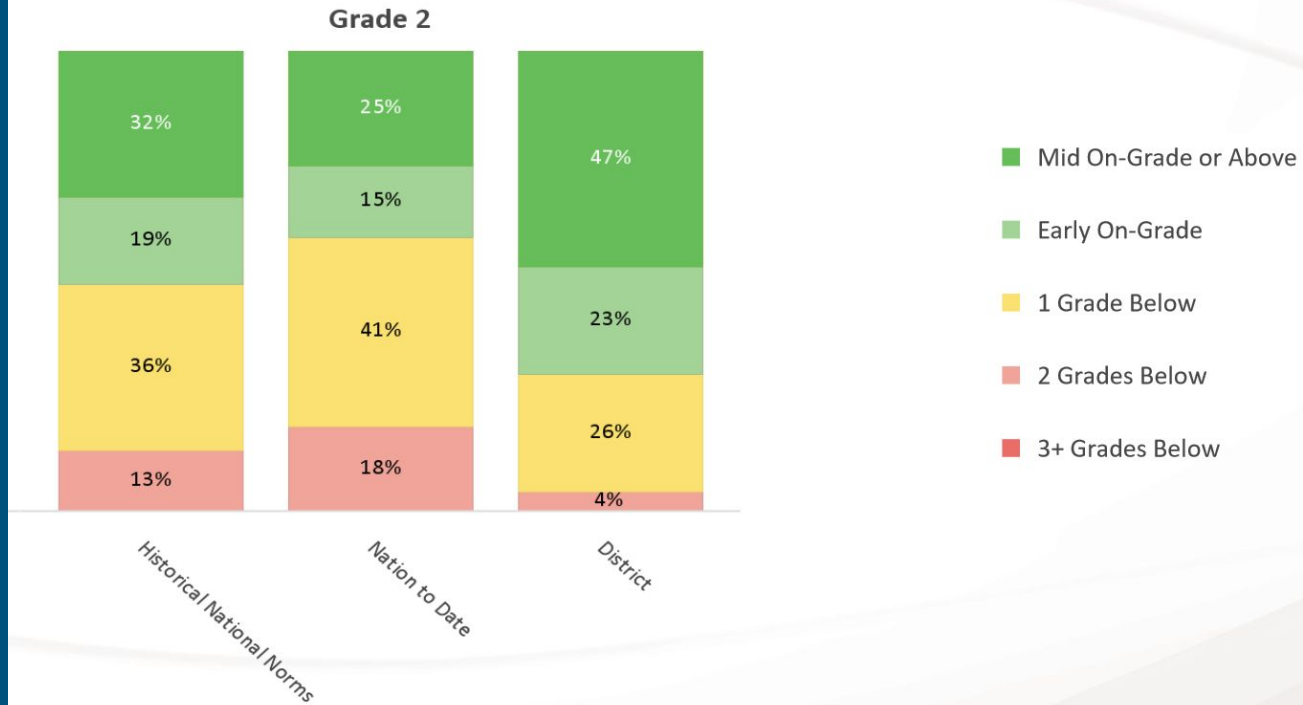

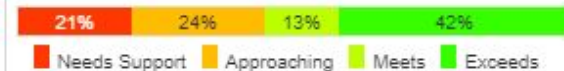

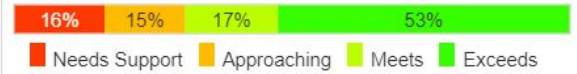

2 Grades Below

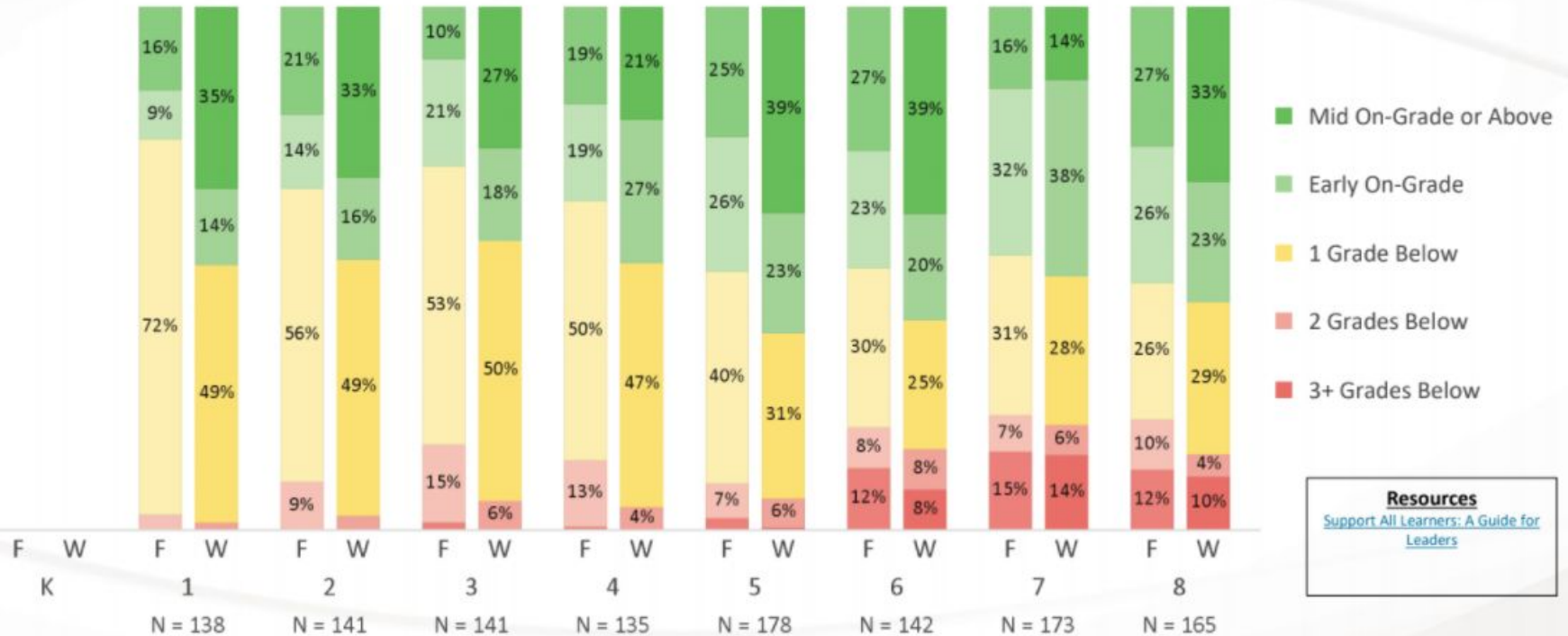

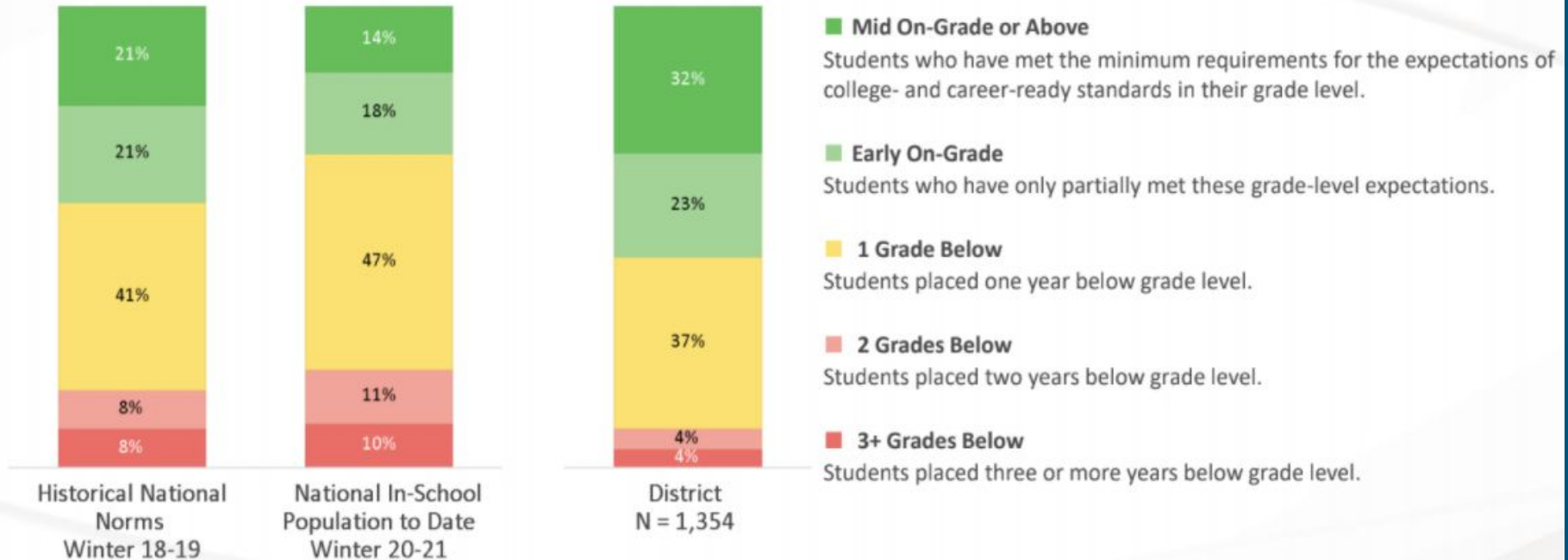
Placement Distribution, Fall 20-21 to Winter 20-21

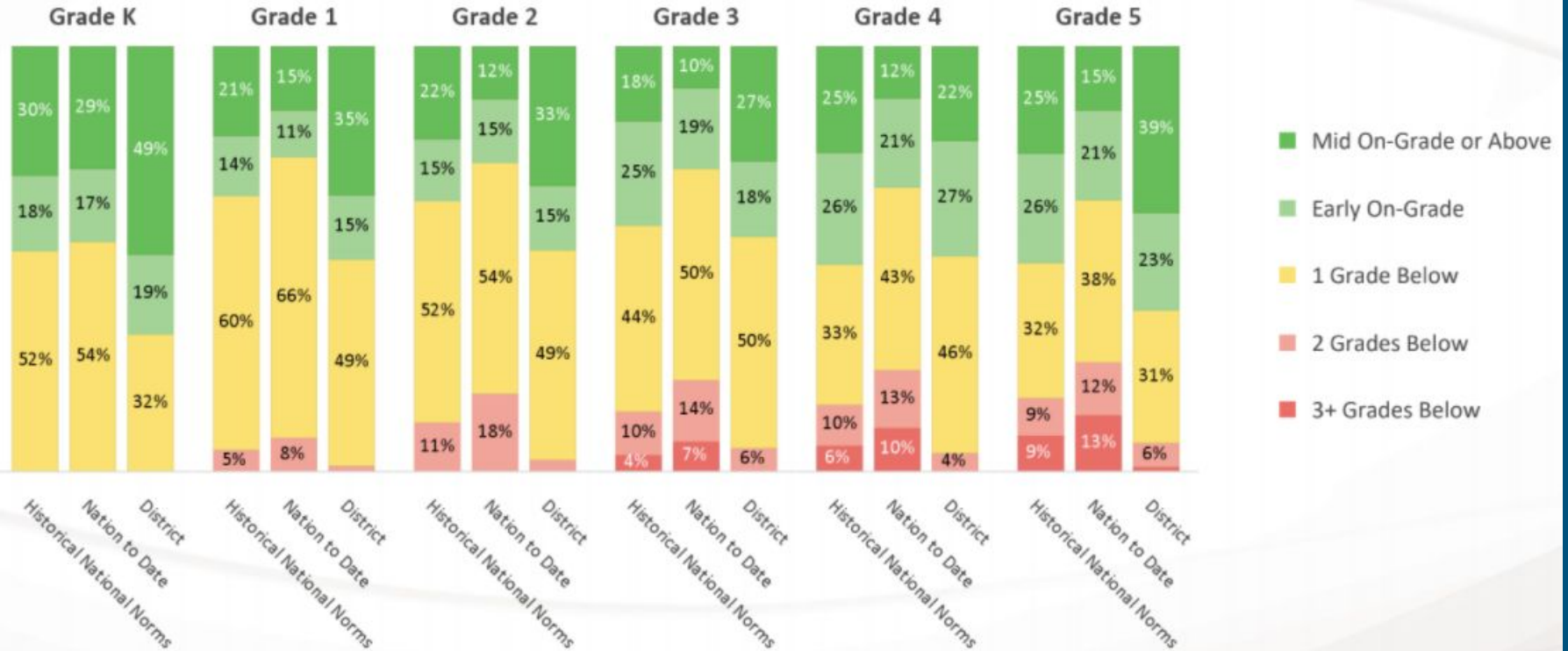
Winter Placement Distribution for District and Benchmarks

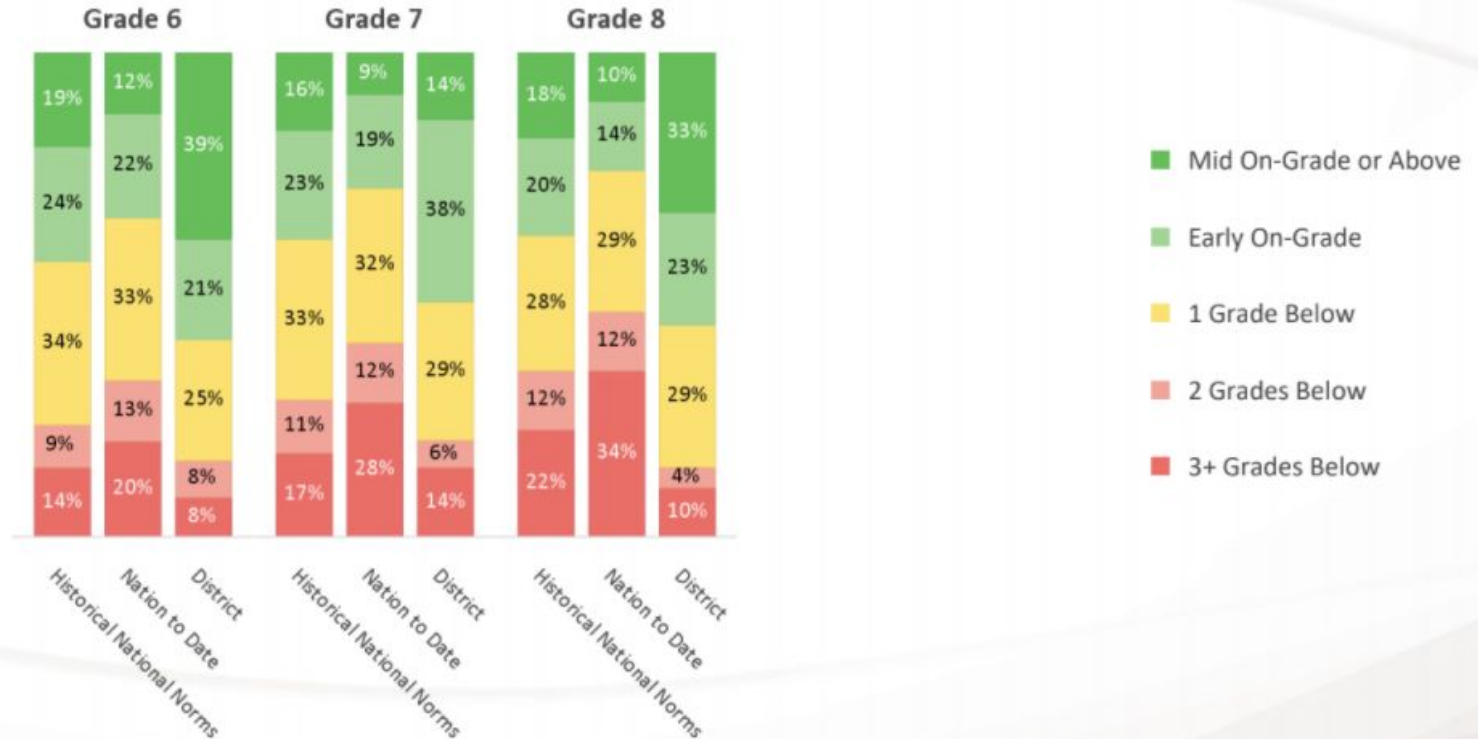

Programs and Supports

- Time built into the pacing guide to address unfinished learning
- Training on data analysis and small group instruction
- Training opportunities for hybrid workshop model in August, September, and December
- Teachers were provided with iReady training from consultants during in-service days
- Individual and grade level coaching
- 2nd grade free pilot of i-Ready Reading personalized learning
- 2nd grade intervention teachers used iReady data to create and track individualized learning goals for students
- Implemented a new intervention schedule for K-5 this year
- Push in intervention services in kindergarten classrooms where scheduling permits
- Students at RMS are using i-Ready online instruction twice a week during academic support and are receiving additional live instruction once a week
- Summer and After School Learning Acceleration programs are in the planning phase.
