Process for Determining and Submitting Scores

- School Climate Team led by School Counselor completes the self assessment
- Building results are reported to Anti-Bullying Coordinator
- Data is compiled and presented to Board of Education upon approval from building principals and the Anti-Bullying Specialists
- Self Assessment results are entered onto the NJDOE website for final submission



Self Assessment Scoring Rubric

8 Core Elements:

- HIB Programs, Approaches or Other Initiatives
- Training on the BOE-approved HIB Policy
- Other Staff Instruction and Training Programs
- Curriculum and Instruction on HIB and Related Information and Skills
- HIB Personnel
- School-Level HIB Incident Reporting Procedure
- HIB Investigation Procedure
- HIB Reporting

*There are indicators within each core element. There are a total of **26 indicators**.



Grading Scale for Each Indicator within each Core Element:

- 1-Partially Meets the Requirements
- 2-Meets All Requirements
- 3-Exceeds Requirements

Highest Possible Score is 78.

Note: If a school met all requirements and received a 2 (meets all requirements) for every indicator, their final score would be a 52.
